STEP 2: DEACTIVATE "FIND MY IPHONE"

- 3. Tap Find My. If it is turned on, turn it off
- 4. Select **OK** to confirm
- 5. Enter your Apple ID password and select Turn off

STEP 3: REMOVE YOUR SIM CARD

Remove your SIM card from the device. Gently insert a small pin or paper clip into the pinhole on the side of your iPhone until the SIM card tray pops out. Remove your SIM card and reinsert the tray.



STEP 4: RESET YOUR DEVICE TO ITS ORIGINAL FACTORY SETTINGS

Resetting your device deletes your contacts, photos, messages and other content.

Be sure that you have successfully backed up or saved all desired content before you reset your device as this cannot be undone. To reset your iPhone to its original factory settings, follow the steps below:

- 1. From the **Home** screen, tap **Settings**
- 2. Tap General
- 3. Tap Reset4. Tap Erase all content and settings
